To maintain protection: Service interval: 30,000 miles. Engine service interval: 5,000 miles. Up to 9,500 pounds GVW.

30K

(30,000/60,000/90,000/120,000/150,000/180,000/210,000 miles)

- Premier courtesy check
- Drain & renew engine oil & oil filter
- Visual brake inspection

- Service battery, including pads
- Check A/C & heater operation
- Lubricate suspension, doors, & hood
- Clean fuel system (gas & diesel)
- Replace air filter & cabin filter
- Flush transmission fluid
- Flush coolant/antifreeze
- Reset engine maintenance light
- Road test and written evaluation
- Service differential(s)
- Power Steering flush
- Brake flush
- Can of oil additive
- Timing belt and acc. replace (60K)
